



An application and affidavit having been filed in the Court by the above-named Plaintiff requesting that a Temporary Protection Order against any acts of violence, threats, harassment and/or causing emotional distress be issued by this Court against YOU, **Ronald Napoles** the above-named Defendant, in the Court having jurisdiction over the parties, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from specific facts shown by a verified application that an act of violence, threats, harassment and/or causing emotional distress has occurred or there exists a threat of violence, threats, harassment and/or causing emotional distress and good cause appearing for issuing such Order without hearing, **YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ **YOU ARE PROHIBITED**, either directly or through an agent, from threatening, physically injuring or harassing the above-named Plaintiff and/or minor child(ren).
2. \_\_\_\_\_ **YOU ARE PROHIBITED** from selling, damaging, destroying, giving away, or otherwise disposing of, or tampering with, any property owned by the Plaintiff, or in which Plaintiff has an interest.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ **YOU ARE PROHIBITED** from any contact whatsoever with the Plaintiff, including but not limited to, in person, by telephone, by text or picture message, through the mail, through electronic mail (e-mail) or through another person;
4. \_\_\_\_\_ **YOU ARE EXCLUDED AND ORDERED** to stay at least 100 yards away from Plaintiff's residence located at where applicant resides. YOU shall not interfere with Plaintiff's possession and use of the residence, including utilities, phones, leases and other related residential services;
5.   X   **YOU MAY NOT ENTER AND OCCUPY**  
**Bishop Paiute Tribal Lands – Block 3, Lots 6 & 7.**
6. \_\_\_\_\_ A Tribal Representative and/or law enforcement officer, within whose jurisdiction Plaintiff's residence is located, shall on **ONE OCCASION ONLY** accompany Defendant to Plaintiff's residence located at , , and shall stand by while Ronald Napoles

obtains the following: .

**ANY PROPERTY NOT LISTED ABOVE IN DISPUTE SHALL  
REMAIN IN THE RESIDENCE;**

7. \_\_\_\_\_ The Court, having jurisdiction grants to Plaintiff temporary custody of the following minor child(ren) of the parties: .  
**YOU ARE PROHIBITED** from interfering with Plaintiff's custody of the minor child(ren) named in this paragraph. Child stealing is a felony offense, punishable by possible incarceration. It is in the best interest of the child(ren) that no negative, insulting, or disparaging comments be made by one party against the other party in the presence of the minor child(ren).
8. \_\_\_\_\_ Custody, visitation, and support of minor child(ren) of the parties shall remain as ordered the in the Decree of Divorce/Order entered between the parties in case number \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ Court of the State of \_\_\_\_\_.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ **YOU ARE EXCLUDED AND ORDERED** to stay at least 100 yards away from the minor child(ren)'s school, or day care located at: \_\_\_\_\_

12. X Notwithstanding other provisions of this Order, the following provisions and exceptions are made a part of this Order: \_\_\_\_\_  
Only exception allowed is for removal of the fencing, livestock, storage container(s), signs, and any other articles that have been placed on the property in attempts to occupy the land (Block 3, Lots 6 & 7) in any form. Only individuals authorized by Tribal Council shall enter premises.

14. \_\_\_\_\_ The Clerk of the Court shall forthwith transmit a copy of this Order, together with the verified application and supporting affidavit, to the Inyo County Sheriff's Office. The Bishop Paiute Tribal Court Process Server will promptly attempt to serve the same upon the Defendant and upon service file return service to the Court by the end of next business day after service is made.

15. \_\_\_\_\_ If you wish to dispute the Order or have it changed, you may request a Hearing by filing a written request with the Court within (2) days of service upon you. The Court will set a hearing on your request as quickly as possible.


16. X **THIS ORDER WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL 11:59P.M. ON**

**UNLESS THE JUDGE ORDERS OTHERWISE.** If an application for an Extended Order is filed within the effective period of this Temporary Order, this Temporary Order will remain in effect until the Hearing on an Extended Order is held.

**ORDER TO: Any Police Officers, Sheriff, Marshall, Constable, or Peace Officer:**

(A) Any law enforcement officer who has probable cause to believe a violation of any provision of this ORDER has occurred is ordered to arrest the Defendant. Such party is to be charged with a misdemeanor violation of this Order in addition to any other criminal charges which may be justified.

(B) If such law enforcement officer cannot verify that the Defendant was served with a copy of the Application and Order, the officer shall inform the Defendant of the specific terms of the Order, inform the Defendant that he/she now has notice of the provisions of the order and that a violation of the Order will result in his/her arrest, and inform the Defendant of the location of the Court that issued the original Order and the hours during which he/she can obtain a copy of the Order. The law enforcement officer shall then provide written proof of the notice to his agency and to the Court.
