SATURDAY, JUNE 8

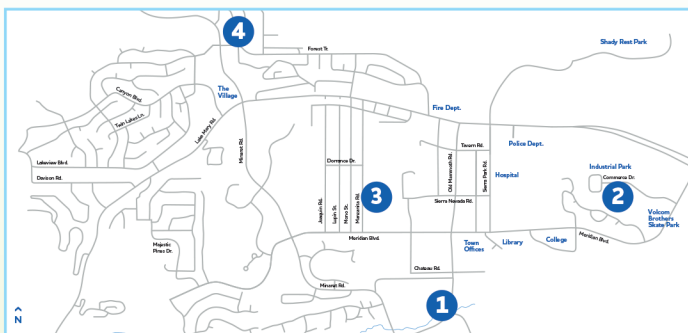
Take pride in your neighborhood and help clean up our town!

The Town encourages property owners, renters, community groups, local non-profit organizations and homeowner associations to pitch in to clean up their neighborhood.

Beginning at 8am, Saturday, June 8, you can drop off your trash, recycling and green waste at the Town Clean Up Day Stations conveniently located throughout town, or directly to the Mammoth Disposal Station in the Industrial Park.

Pick up your free bags today at Town Offices or the Mammoth Disposal Station, or use your own. Please do not leave bags on the side of the road, as they will not be picked up.

ITEMS TO DELIVER TO:

Town Clean Up Day Stations **3** **4**

Large Bulky Items

Furniture, appliances, old tires, heavy metal, mattresses, etc. Refrigerators must be delivered to the Mammoth Disposal Station.

Metal Objects

Appliances, large metal objects, snow stakes, metal waste, etc.

Green Waste

Pine cones, needles, grass clippings, leaf debris, etc. Empty bags into roll-off bins.

Recyclable Materials

Plastic, glass, etc.

No food or construction waste! These items are accepted at the Mammoth Disposal Station.

Mammoth Disposal Station **2**

Metal Objects*

Refrigerators, snow stakes, washing machines, etc. Snowmobiles and snowblowers (all oil, gas and gas tanks must be removed).

HHW: Hazardous Household Waste/Items*

Batteries, TVs, electronics, fluorescent-tubed lights, hazardous liquids (water and oil-based paint, motor oil).

Food Waste

Food scraps, compost items, etc.

Green Waste

Pine cones, needles, grass clippings, leaf debris, etc. Tree limbs less than 12" in diameter.*

*Mammoth Disposal will accept these items free of charge on June 8 only.

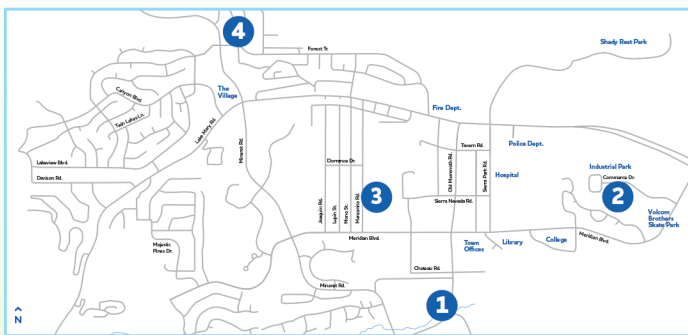
¡Siéntase orgulloso de su vecindario y ayude a limpiar nuestro pueblo!

MATERIALES A DEJAR EN:

Clean Up Day Station **3** **4** en el Pueblo

Objetos Grandes

Muebles, electrodomésticos, neumáticos viejos, metales pesados, colchones, etc. Los refrigeradores deben ser llevados al Puesto de Desechos de Mammoth.

Objetos Metálicos

Electrodomésticos, objetos metálicos grandes, patines de nieve, desechos metálicos, etc.

Restos Verdes

Piñas, pinochas, pasto, hojas, etc. Bolsas vacías dentro de los contenedores de arrastre.

Material Reciclable

Plástico, Vidrio, etc.

¡Ni comida ni materiales de construcción!

Mammoth Disposal Station **2**

Objetos Metálicos*

Refrigeradores, patines de nieve, lavadoras, etc. Motos de nieve y máquinas quita nieve (libres de todo aceite, combustible y tanques de combustible).

Desechos Domésticos Peligrosos/Objetos*

Baterías, televisores, dispositivos electrónicos, tubos de luz fluorescentes, líquidos peligrosos (pinturas a base de agua y aceite, aceite de motor)

Residuos de comidas

Restos de comida, materiales para compost, etc.

Restos Verdes

Piñas, pinocha, pasto, hojas, etc.
Ramas de árbol menores de 30 cm de diámetro.*

*Mammoth Disposal aceptará estos desechos sin cargo solamente el 8 de junio.
